### Uniform Policy & Agreement

River City Rhythm (RCR) requires all members to read, agree to & sign the Uniform Policy and Agreement form prior to being issued a uniform. It is understood that members who are under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal representative sign the form as it is a binding contract between the member and RCR. Members 18 and older will sign for themselves.

#### Policy / Agreement

It is agreed and understood that:

1. The entire uniform is the property of River City Rhythm. The uniform includes but is not limited to Pants, Shirts/Tops, Shoes, and any other item assigned by the Head Director to be a part of the uniform that was purchased by RCR and provided as part of said uniform.
2. Items purchased, at the request of the Head Director, by the member remains the personal property of the individual member.
3. It is the member's responsibility to maintain the integrity of the uniform by keeping it clean (laundering) and in good repair. RCR requires that any alterations, revisions, and maintenance to the uniform be made by or supervised by the RCR's uniforms committee chair or designated appointee.
4. The agreed upon value of the uniform is \$100.00 (one hundred dollars). In the event that the member loses, destroys, or for any reason does not return any part of the uniform they will be held liable for the entire value of the uniform. Appeals to this policy may be made by the member or head director on a case by case basis. Outcomes of the appeal are at the sole discretion of the board of directors. All decisions are final.

I agree to this policy and understand its contents. If I had any questions I have asked them and have received an adequate response prior to signing the agreement.
